- Applicants may choose to install culverts themselves or by private contractor.
- Inspection shall be made before the applicant backfills the culverts, and it shall be the applicant's responsibility to contact the permit office a minimum of five (5) days in advance to schedule the inspection.
- Applicants installing culverts themselves shall supply all necessary labor, equipment and materials to complete the work.
- Failure to obtain a favorable inspection will ultimately result in the removal of said culverts.
- Drainage of roadway and the roadside ditches shall not be altered or impacted.
- Where the proper size culverts cannot be installed, on grade, and without impeding or altering said drainage, the application shall be denied.
- To facilitate proper roadway drainage, inlets shall be placed a minimum of three (3) inches below the edge of pavement nearest to the culvert installation.
- The parish may deny applicant's request to install culverts where an unreasonable hardship such as property flooding can be expected to occur as a result of the installation.
- To improve the installation circumstances the applicant may be allowed to place additional backfill on his/her property.
- For all installations it shall be the responsibility of the applicant to properly grade his/her property to drain toward the drainage inlets. Cost of materials, labor and equipment for this purpose shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
- The parish reserves the right to reject any material (pipe, backfill, etc.) it deems unsuitable for the proposed intent.
- Unpermitted driveway culverts may result in the removal of the driveway culvert by the parish.
- The replacement of residential culverts exceeding 30ft. and non-residential culverts exceeding 40 ft. will be the responsibility of the property owner to replace when the parish is performing road and/or drainage maintenance improvements in the location of the existing culvert(s).
